Fastpitch teams are permitted to add or substitute four players as follows:

- Pick up players may be from teams anywhere in the state that have not been disqualified for eligibility or unsportsmanlike conduct violations.
- Added players may be from anywhere in the state as long as they are no longer eligible for championship play. Teams may pick up a maximum of one pitcher. Exception: Class C teams playing B MFP State may pickup two pitchers.
- Pickup players in Minnesota need not have played for an NSF ♦ MSF registered team during the current season, but must be approved by the NSF ♦ MSF state office.
- Pickup players may be selected only for teams which are no longer eligible for championship play.
- Pickup players may be from a fastpitch, slowpitch or modified pitch team in the same or lower classification. Players who are members of two teams in two different classifications must assume their highest class of play for pick up purposes. (e.g. if a player is participating on a class B team in one community and a class C team in another, they are considered a class B player for pick up purposes and consequently may only be picked up for a class B tournament or higher). **Exception:** Class C MFP teams playing in B State may pickup Class B players or below.
- No players may be picked up for National Qualifiers.
- In adult divisions of play, pickup player may be substituted for after they have participated.
- A player may play with only one team other than their own team within a division in championship play. **Exception:** C MFP teams playing in B MFP State.
- "Pick-up" players may be dropped and substituted for with other legal "pick-up" players.
- Pickup players must sign an official "pickup player" form which also must be signed by the team's manager, league director **and if a minor the player's parent or legal guardian** and attached to the team's official roster before tournament play begins. The pickup form is located in the current NSF ♦ MSF Softball Guide Book.

PLAYER WAIVER, RELEASE OF LIABILITY & INDEMNIFICATION AGREEMENT

PLAYER STATEMENT Each player shall read the following statements before signing. I am a member in good standing of the above team and I am eligible under local sports community and NSF ♦ MSF eligibility rules to compete with this team in local sports community and NSF ♦ MSF tournament play. I understand that I may participate in only one MSF post-season tournament in the same division of play and my signature may appear on only one post-season tournament roster in the same division of play. For the definition of "divisions of play" please see the applicable NSF ♦ MSF Guidebook. I agree to abide by the rules and regulations established for local sports community and NSF ♦ MSF play.

HOLD HARMLESS WAIVER OF LIABILITY: I, the undersigned player, acknowledge, agree and understand that: 1. Voluntarily and of my own free will, I elect to participate as a member of amateur sports team and league indicated above. 2. I understand that there are certain risks and hazards involved in playing softball that may result in injury or death to me or other players, including, but not limited to those hazards associated with weather conditions, playing conditions, equipment and other participants. 3. I understand that the very nature of sports participation is hazardous and risky, including, but not limited to, hitting or catching a ball, blocking, swinging a bat, running, jumping, stretching, sliding, diving, and collisions with other players and with stationary objects, all of which can cause serious injury or death to me and to other players. Further, I, the undersigned player, agree that in consideration for the right to play as a member of the team designated above and in consideration for permission to play on the courts, rinks or fields arranged for by the team or league: 1. I voluntarily elect to accept and assume all risks of injury incurred or suffered by me (a) while practicing or playing as a member of the team so designated, (b) while serving in a non-playing capacity as a team member during practice or play by other teams or by both players on my team, and (c) while on or upon the premises of any and all of the facilities arranged for by my team or league for practice or play. 2. I release, discharge and agree not to sue the team and league designated above, the fieldowner or other entity designated above, the National Softball Federation of America - Minnesota Sports Federation, or their owners, officers, agents, servants, associations, employees, or any person or entity connected with the team, league, field or National Softball Federation of America - Minnesota Sports Federation for any claim, damages, costs or cause of action which I have or may in the future have as a result of injuries or damages sustained or incurred by me from whatever cause including but not limited to the negligence, breach of contract or wrongful conduct of the parties hereby released.
