## Class B-D Co-Rec Slow Pitch State Championships

Dear Team Manager:

We hope this note finds you enjoying the 2018 season.

Because the number of teams playing Class B-D Co-Rec Softball has been shrinking, teams may now be formed specifically for Class B-C Co-Rec State Tournament play. Class B-C Co-Rec teams need not play in a registered league and may enter the state tournament direct via U.S. Mail or online at [www.msf1.org](http://www.msf1.org). Class D intact league teams may also enter direct at the link above.

For legal composition of a Class B-D team, see the below table. A player's team class is based on the last men's or women's team they played on. Teams that were classified A, B, C or D co-rec last year may not move down without an official petition and approval.

**Co-Rec Slow Pitch**

Co-Rec B = Allowed maximum of 3 players who played on A men's, women's or co-rec team in previous or current season

Co-Rec C = Allowed maximum of 3 players who played on B men's, women's or co-rec team in previous or current season (no players from A teams)

Co-Rec D = Allowed maximum of 3 players who played on C men's, women's or co-rec team in previous or current season (no players from A or B teams)

We hope your players' schedules allow you to join us for the 2018 Co-Rec State Tournament in Cambridge.

# Class B-D Co-Rec Slow Pitch State Championships



<b>What:</b>	<b>2018 Class B-D Co-Rec Slow Pitch State Championships</b>
<b>When:</b>	<b>August 4-5</b>
<b>Where:</b>	<b>Sandquist Family Park, Cambridge</b>
<b>Eligibility:</b>	<b>Teams must be NSF+MSF registered (included in entry fee). See reverse for team composition rules.</b>
<b>Roster Deadline:</b>	<b>Official roster (20 max) shall be submitted at tournament site prior to first game. To enter Class D, teams must play as an intact league team. Three players Class D or below may be picked up from your league for state tournament play.</b>
<b>Entry Fee:</b>	<b>\$200</b>
<b>Entry Deadline:</b>	<b>Friday, July 23rd</b>
<b>Structure:</b>	<b>Three game guarantee. If necessary, classes may be initially combined and the bracket classes determined by won/loss.</b>
<b>Game Officials:</b>	<b>NSF+MSF registered umpires shall be utilized on all contests</b>
<b>Awards:</b>	<b>Team plaques for 1st-3rd and individual awards for first and second place, championships banner for first place (based on 8 teams in each class)</b>
<b>Softballs:</b>	<b>44/375 11" softballs and 52/300 12" softballs will be provided</b>
