## **2019 Steamboat Days Softball Tournament Rules**

1. All teams must be NSF-MSF sanctioned or pay a \$5 or \$15 sanction fee to become sanctioned and turn in a filled out "Sanction Invitational Tournament Team membership application form" found in the back of the NSF-MSF guide book.
2. The "Rock" balls will be provided for the tournament - Men's Cor 52/300 Maximum Compression softballs.
3. 4 home runs per game, excess home runs will be outs.
4. 20 run rule after 4 innings, 12 run rule after 5 innings. (No run rule in effect for money games.)
5. Three balls-two strike rule in effect (no courtesy foul)
6. Plate and mat are a strike.
7. Six to twelve foot arch.
8. 20 man roster limit, which can include two pick-ups. Two pick-up names must be given to the Tournament Headquarters (JC Shelter) AT LEAST ½ hour before your first game.
9. Courtesy runners are allowed and are not limited to injured players. Courtesy runner must be the person who made the last previous out or someone who has not yet entered the game-re-entry.
10. No grace period, all games will be on time.
11. The casual profanity rule will be enforced.
12. Umpire's decision is final, NO PROTESTS.
13. Home team is determined by the flip of a coin.
14. No metal spikes will be allowed.
15. No refund, payment of entry fee confirms understanding of rules.
16. The Tournament Director reserves the right to change format i.e. change times and/or fields. IF rain interrupts play, we will make every effort to play the tourney in its entirety.
17. The Tournament Director and staff along with the Winona Steamboat Days Festival Association will not be responsible for any accidents or injuries in connection with this tournament.
18. Entry form and entry due by June 3<sup>rd</sup>, 2019. You will be notified by email on the time you play after June 7<sup>th</sup>, 2019.
19. Double, triple, and multiple wall bats are legal. Must fit ring, no dents, cracks, appropriate taping, having a legal knob. All bats need to be and will be checked in at Tournament Headquarters (JC Shelter) AT LEAST ½ hour before your first game. All bats will be marked, umpires need not let any player use a bat that has not been checked in and marked. Bats must be ASA Certified-see website-[www.asasoftball.com](http://www.asasoftball.com) for the illegal and legal bat list.
20. Must have 8 players to start a game and 8 players to finish.
21. All NSF-MSF rules apply.
22. No base stealing.
23. If player is ejected from game, they must leave field and premises immediately and player is disqualified for the rest of the tournament.
