We hope this note finds your staying healthy and well during the COVID-19 summer!

As you may know, your league may not be affiliated with the NSF ♦ MSF this season by your league's leadership. Because your team has been affiliated with the NSF ♦ MSF in the past or you may not have been given an option/vote on affiliation this year, we are extending an invitation to teams like yours to participate in the NSF ♦ MSF program again this year, in hopes you will encourage your league to be re-affiliated with the NSF ♦ MSF in the future. That ball and determination is in your court at this point. If your league is affiliated with NSF ♦ MSF, you must enter post-season state tournament play via your league director, except for Co-Rec Slow, Church Slow, Masters Slow and Class B Men's Fastpitch State Tournaments, where you may enter direct via flyer or online at www.msf1.org.

The NSF ♦ MSF continues to offer the greatest team membership benefits at the lowest possible cost. This includes our state tournaments which lead to the North American Championships/Tournament of Champions in Cambridge this year (see accompanying flyer or go to www.msf1.org).

Our state tournaments are double elimination and three game guarantee if there are 15 entries or less. Awards provided are quality and of high distinction. All member teams receive the best and biggest scorebook/rulebook produced, a member bag tag and program guidebook.

Teams like yours who recruit an additional team from your non-MSF league that did not play postseason last year will receive a \$10 per team recruited discount on your state tournament entry fee (a team is defined as having five or more returning players from last year for purposes of this promotion). Please inform us if you recruit any teams from your league that did not play last year.

Non-MSF registered teams may use the entry form on the reverse side or enter online. Go to www.msf1.org and click on the "Adult Softball" tab to register. It is very important you enter your last MSF team class/correct class!

Roster Deadline:	July 15. Roster form will be postal mailed to you upon receipt of your entry.
Entry Fee:	\$225 - includes team membership fee
Entry Deadline:	Two weeks prior to the start of state tournament play. Teams should print online advancing team packet and review!
Structure:	Double Elimination or Three Game Guarantee (if 15 teams or less)
Game Officials:	NSF ♦ MSF registered umpires
Softballs:	52/300 (men's ball) & 44/375 (women's ball) provided by NSF ♦ MSF
Awards:	Team plaques for 1st-3rd and individual awards for 1st place. Championship banner for first place (awards based on 8 or more teams).
