Tim Started playing/pitching in 1974, in the Lakes fast-pitch league, as an 8<sup>th</sup> grader in Jr. High. He pitched for over 20 years all the way from Canada to Texas. He had three (3) main pitches: riser, drop, and knuckle ball change up, and threw them all with authority. He played on numerous All Star teams and was a favorite to be picked up by hopeful tournament teams.

Tim Played with different sponsors along the way: starting with 1st National Bank, Anderson Trucking, Kingdom Realty, and Bergseth Bros. Distributing (Coors Lite). He was fortunate to play with the same team members for the most of his softball career.



I wish to show my support for the nomination of Tim Erb to the Minnesota Softball Hall of Fame. In 1980, I signed a teaching contract with a Detroit Lakes area school. I was the District 7 DUIC for fast pitch softball. That summer I umpired the Detroit Lakes Fast Pitch League working most of my games in Callaway. The DL league had many great pitchers, Ken Pearson, Kevin Olson, and Dave Ferguson to name a few. But the fastest pitcher and the one who's ball moved the most, was Tim Erb. As an umpire you had to focus and not call the pitch too soon, as it might move several inches in the last 10 feet. As an umpire, he was a nightmare to work, because of his speed and ball movement. Fortunately, he had a great catcher that rarely let the ball by.

If I missed a pitch or two, he would give you that "look" and get back on the rubber. He was one of the best.

Tim is someone that loves fast pitch softball and was a fierce competitor. He is well qualified to be placed in the HOF.
